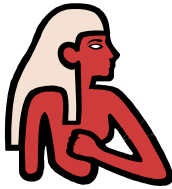




# Ancient Egypt

Discover more about the Ancient Egyptians by taking part in a **gallery tour** or **hands-on gallery activity** at the Ashmolean Museum.

### Gallery Tour

Cost FREE  
Max group size 36 (divided in to 3 groups of 12, each with a museum education guide)  
Length of session 45 minutes  
*Groups can also book time after the tour to sketch and draw in the galleries.*

### Hands-On Gallery activity

Cost FREE  
Max group size 36  
Length of session 1 hour and 30 minutes

### Self-conducted visit

Cost FREE  
Max group size We suggest approx 36 children  
Length of session Variable, but approx 1 hour
