Regulations

Copyright Regulations for the reproduction of images in multimedia and CD-ROM

- The digital representations of each image shall be no greater than standard VGA, specifically 640x480 pixels.
- The Publisher agrees to label images using image identification codes provided in order to facilitate the identification of unauthorised copies. In addition, the Publisher agrees to encrypt digital images using a de-encryption key unique to the specific product.
- The product shall be designed so that the digital images are not accessible as individual files. Specifically, it shall not be possible to copy or otherwise extract the images in the normal course of using the product except to print pages for personal use
- The product must bear a strongly worded copyright notice on the outer packaging, on the storage medium and on any documentation that may accompany the product. It must explain in clear language that the contents are protected by copyright law and the following are prohibited: Public performance or display, including transmission over a network; The preparation of any derivative work, including the extraction, in whole or in part, of any image. Any rental lease, or lending of the product.
- Any correction or alteration to the image in any way must be approved in advance of publication.
- Reproduction rights are non-exclusive, cover all languages and are granted on the basis of a given production run. Any further production run, or any further edition or use, will require written permission and may incur additional fees (i.e. in the form of a conventionally printed book or part-work, or in any other publication on CD-ROM).
- The Publisher shall be responsible for ensuring that any third-party distributor of the product is bound by the terms of

this document.

- On publication, all digital copies of the image(s), except those on the master disk to be used for further production runs, shall be destroyed. No further copies shall be made except those made from the master as a part of the product to be distributed and sold in any additional print run.

- Users will be required to sign a copy of this agreement.
