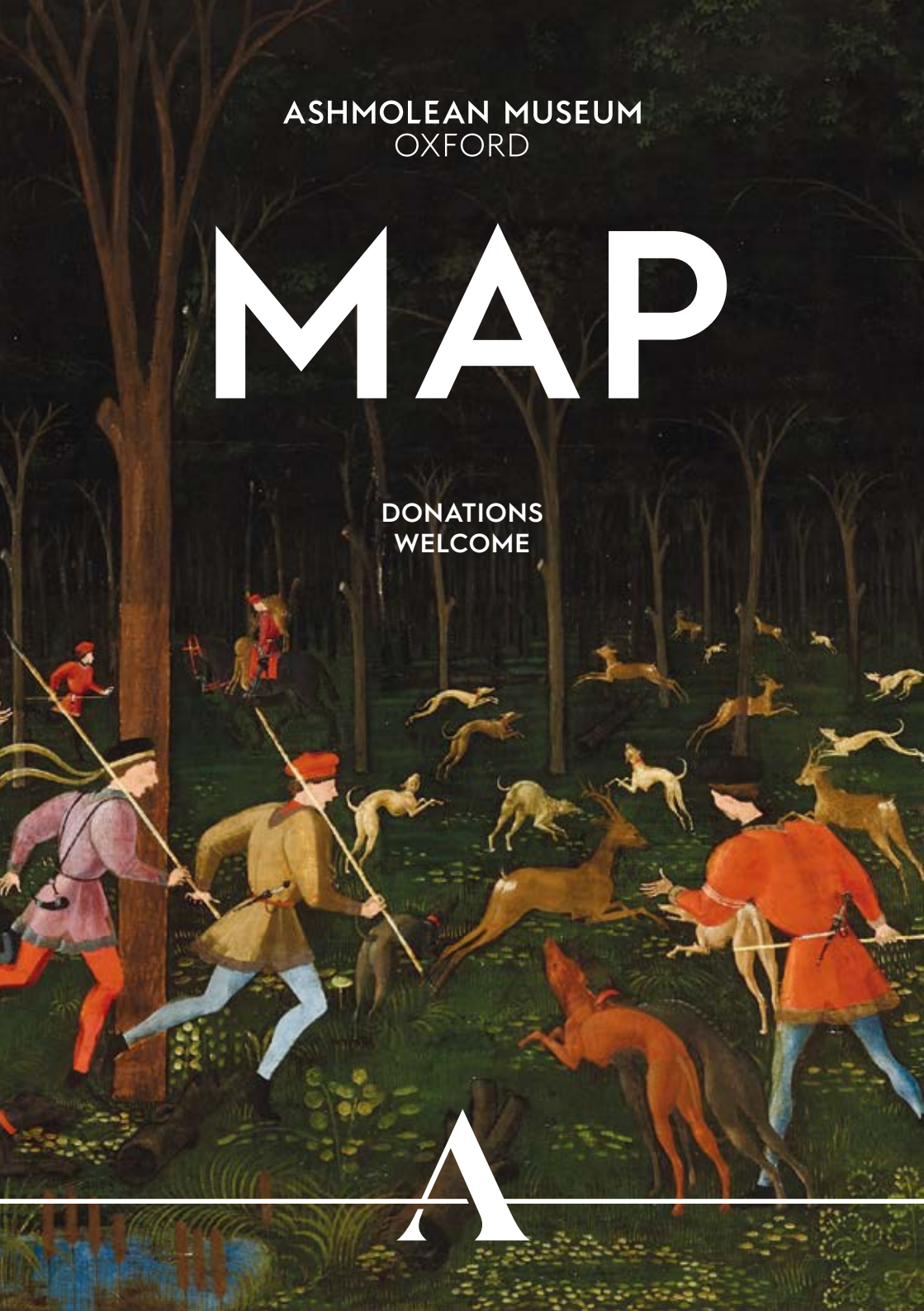

## ★ Guy Fawkes' Lantern

Guy Fawkes is said to have been carrying this iron lantern when he was arrested during one of the most dramatic moments in British history.

On **Level G** find out how travel brought the ancient world together, including in Egypt, Greece and China.

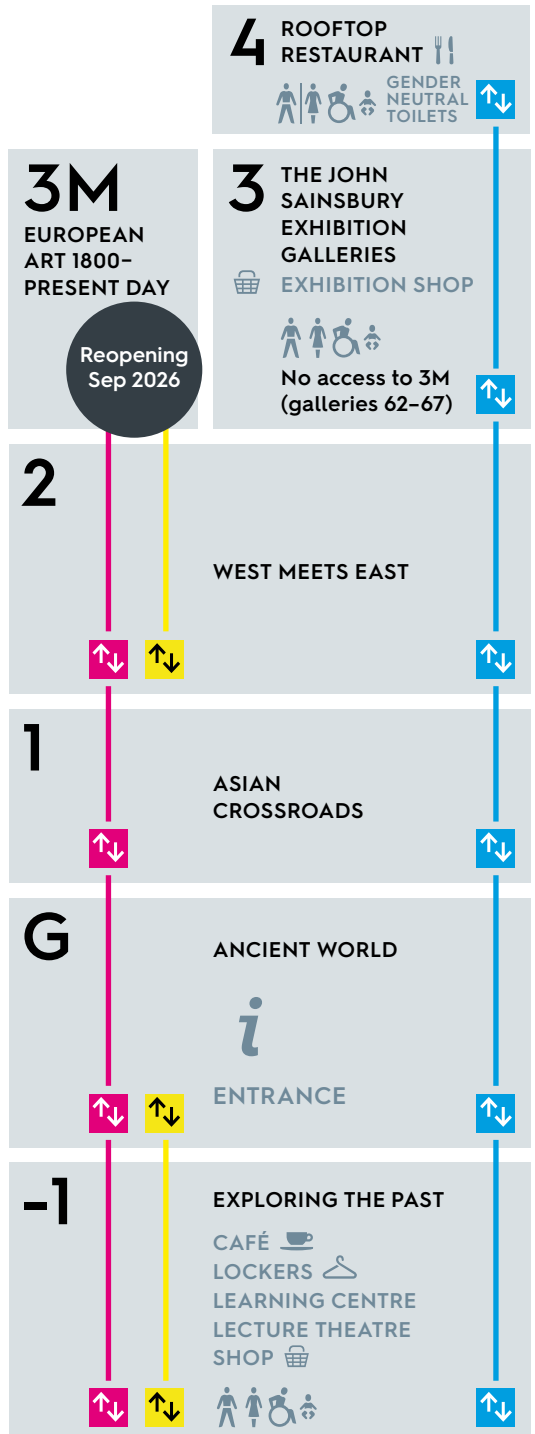
Explore the world of the Silk Road and sea trade routes between the Mediterranean and Asia on **Level 1**.
