
#### INTIMATE CEREMONY


## DRINKS RECEPTION






# ROOFTOP DINING ROOM & OUTDOOR TERRACE

◆ Dancing girl performing for a Raja 18th century (1701 - 1800) Eastern Art




## EVENING RECEPTION






# REHEARSAL DINNERS & POST WEDDING BRUNCHES

You may host your wedding reception in the Rooftop Restaurant in the daytime, or the evening and in the galleries **from 6.00pm** each evening.




